<p>Children will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Explore the composition from one to 10. (Subitising) 2. Count beyond 10. 3. Have an awareness of number bonds to 10. 4. Continue, copy and create repeating patterns. 5. Compare length, weight and capacity. 	
Things you can do at home:	
<p>Games:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Snakes and Ladders • Dominoes • Dice games • Ladybird counting • Number games • Number puzzles 	<p>Activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Look for numbers and shapes in the environment • Count everything! (food, steps, cars, toys) • Match numbers to different amounts • Encourage your child to talk about numbers. What you can see? How do you see it? • Be familiar with Numberblock characters 1-10. • Number formation practise (using rice/sand/water painting/ play dough).
