Vocabulary	Carnivore	Animals that eat meat.
	Herbivore	Animals that eat plants.
Omnivore	An animal that eats either other animals or plants.	
Predator	An animal that hunts and eats other animals.	
Prey	An animal being hunted by another animal.	
Habitat	The home of an animal.	
Amphibian	A cold blooded animal that lives on land and water.	
Reptile	A cold blooded animal that is usually covered with scales or bony plates.	
Mammal	An animal that breaths air, has a back bone and grows hair at some point during it's life.
