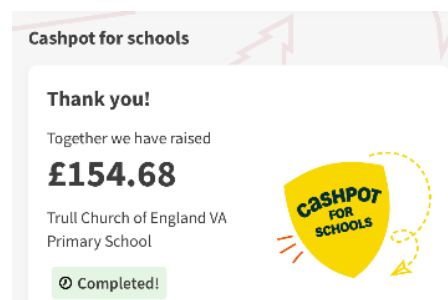
Our new big fundraiser:
