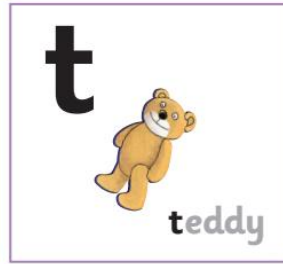
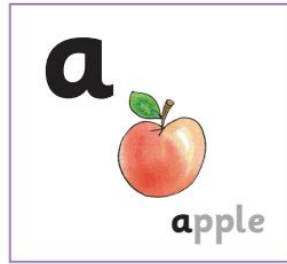


Home Phonics Practice Week 1

This week in phonics we have learnt the following phonemes. Practise saying each sound out loud.



When you are saying each sound remember to keep the sounds pure e.g. 'sssssss' not 'suh'.

Point to the letters below in and out of order. The children say the sounds as quickly as they can.



If your child is keen to mark make, please try to encourage them to use the correct pencil grip. If they are keen to practise letter formation, please help them to start in the correct place.

Fine motor skills ideas

- Peeling and placing stickers
- Ripping or crumpling paper
- Popping bubble rap
- Placing coins in a piggy bank
- Stringing cheerios
