This week in phonics we have learnt the following phonemes. Practise saying each sound aloud.

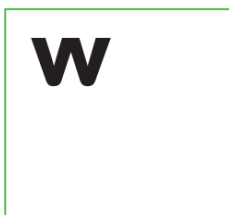
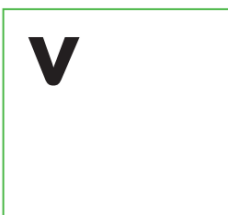


**Phoneme:**

**Digraph:**  
Two letters that make one sound
