

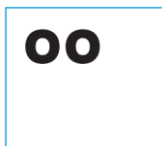
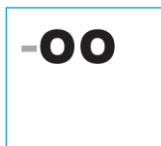
Home Phonics Practice Week 13

Try to spot the new digraphs we have learnt this week by underlining them in the word.

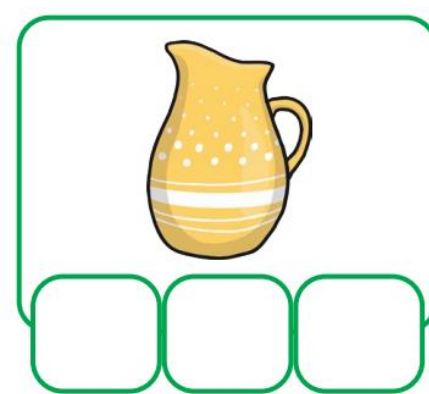
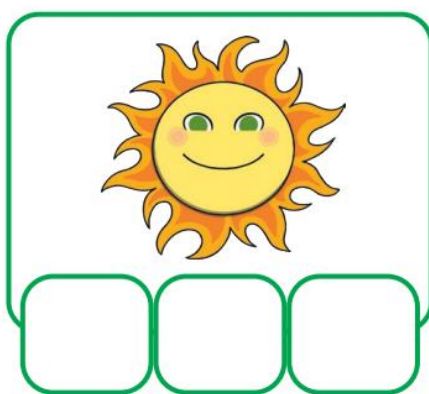
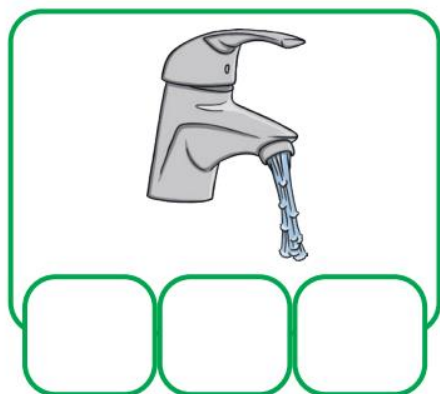


Blending
