As we have been saying to the children this week, get involved, be curious and connect with those around you.

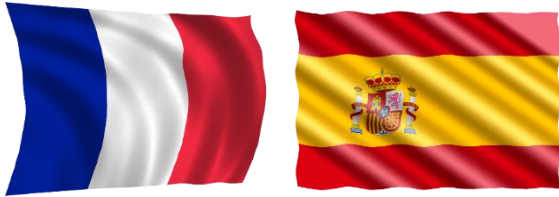


