English



- The children will continue to have daily phonics lessons and extra sessions where needed. They will soon begin to learn alternative graphemes for the phonemes.
- They will continue to develop their reading skills through **Guided Reading** sessions.
- As fluency develops, reading comprehension becomes a real focus.
- The children will have the opportunity to write for a range of purposes throughout the year.
- There will be a bigger focus on **Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar** as they move through Year 1.

How you can help

- Please read regularly with your children at home.
- Please also discuss the books and ask questions to ensure basic comprehension.
- Individual reading books will be changed twice a week.
- When writing at home, please encourage children to use phoneme mats and tricky word mats.
- Please help your child learn new phonemes and tricky words.
- Please help your children learn their spellings as part of their homework. Your child will have a **Spelling Shed** login.

Mathematics

Some of the areas we are covering:

- Place value
- Addition and subtraction within 10, then 20
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Comparing and ordering two-digit numbers
- Writing numbers in digits and words up to 20
- The concepts of multiplication and division

How you can help

- Please give your child opportunities to use mathematical concepts in the home. (Weighing ingredients, measuring, using money, telling the time).
- Help them quickly recall and use their number bonds to 10 and then 20 and then count in 2s, 5s and 10s.

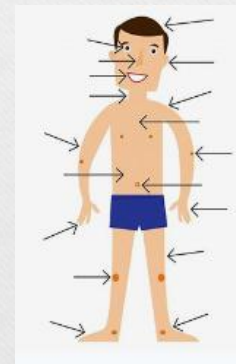
Wow notes
