Friday 28th November – TSF Christmas Fair 3pm – 5pm

Join us for our annual Christmas Fair for lots of festive fun including chocolate tombola, Where's Santa, donuts and more!

Thursday 4th December – EYFS Nativity at 2pm

The children from the Foundation Stage (Reception children) will be performing 'The Nativity' in the School Hall. Seating is limited and to ensure we are following fire safety regulations, the show will be by bookings only. In the first instance there is a limit of three seats per family - please email the school office by Friday 28th November to book. If you require extra seats, please let us know as we will hold a waiting list.

Tuesday 9th December – Y1 & Y2 – Nativity at 2pm

Wednesday 10th December – Y1 & Y2 – Nativity 2pm

Thursday 11th December – Y1 & Y2 – Nativity 9.30am

There will be three performances of the Christmas Play 'Christmas with the Aliens' performed by Years 1 & 2. **The first show is Tuesday afternoon which is repeated on Wednesday afternoon and then Thursday morning.**

All performances will be held in the School Hall. Seating is limited and to ensure we are following fire safety regulations, the show will be by bookings only. In the first instance there is a limit of four seats per family (which can be spread across all three performances) - please email the school office by Friday 28th November to book. If you require extra seats, please let us know as we will hold a waiting list.

Friday 12th December – Christmas Jumper Day

Wear a festive jumper to school with normal school uniform. There will be collection buckets at the school gate for donations to Save the Children.

Tuesday 16th December – Christingle Service

The children will be making Christingles in class and they will finish with a short service in Trull Church in the afternoon. Due to space restrictions, parents will not be able to attend.

There will be two performances of the KS2 Carol Service in Trull Church - the afternoon service is a repeat of the morning service. There are no tickets, but due to limited space we do ask that parents attend the service for their child's year group and this is limited to 2 people only.
