FREE SCHOOL MEAL CHANGES

From 1 September 2026, the criteria for free school meals has changed.

There will be 2 categories of benefits-based free school meals:

Targeted: this covers children in households in receipt of Universal Credit with annual household earnings of £7,400 or less.

Expanded: this covers children who are in households receiving Universal Credit with annual household earnings exceeding £7,400.

Any family that believes they may be eligible under the new expanded criteria must submit an application form to have their eligibility checked.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will continue to receive a universal free school meal.
